Dear Parents/Guardians,

It is hard to believe we are over half-way through the school year and are already making plans for the 2017-2018 school year. I would like to take this time to inform you that our campus has been identified under the Public Education Grant (PEG) Program for the 2017-2018 school year. Our campus in particular is on the list because of an Improvement Required accountability rating in 2014.

Under the PEG transfer provision, a parent of a student enrolled in any of the campuses identified may make an application to attend a campus in any other school district for the 2017-2018 school year. A school district chosen by a student's parent under this statute is entitled to accept or reject the application for the student to attend school in that district, but may not use criteria that discriminates on the basis of a student's race, ethnicity, academic achievement, athletic abilities, language proficiency, sex, or socioeconomic status.
